The second opportunity is to join our relaunched LEAF - Lanesend Active Families. This will be a group of parents, carers alongside members of our staff who will organise and run events for everyone to enjoy whilst raising funds to support our children's enrichment activities. The first one will be on Thursday 26th September. The time will be confirmed next week.

New Opening Times

Thank you for supporting our new gate opening times. The number of late arrivals has been reducing but we do still have several children who are arriving after 8:30 when learning has already started. Now that everyone is familiar with the system, from Monday all children arriving after 8:30 will be recorded as late. From 9:00 they will be marked as an unauthorised absence. The side gate will now be locked at 8:30 so the main gate will need to be used. Also, we will open up the gate for the end of the day at 2:55pm - please do make sure your child is collected on time. On Monday, we will be sharing our Attendance Policy with you which will provide further support and guidance.

Our Houses

We had great excitement this week as we launched our brand new houses! Our four houses are now the four elements: **Earth, Air, Fire and Water**. We have grouped siblings together and have balanced the numbers so each house has similar numbers of children in it.

Next week, we will begin our Celebration Assemblies. These will take place on Thursday at 2:30 for Key Stage 2 and Friday at 2:30 for Key Stage 1. Parents and carers of those children who will be awarded certificates will be contacted the day before so if you are able to join us to celebrate, you would be very welcome.

Payments and communication

- As shared previously, we are no longer using School Money and all payments need to be made on Arbor. Payments for Little Canada will be added on as quickly as possible.
- Please note, our office hours are 7:30 - 4:00.
- Our Office Team are always very busy so please do support them by sending emails or in-app messages whenever possible. We now use email and in-app messaging on Arbor. For help with Relish, please contact the company directly.

Important - Wrap Around Care - The Den, AM and PM Club and Breakfast Club

Please note, from Monday, bookings for any of our Wrap Around care can no longer be made directly with the office. All bookings must be made by midnight the day before. This avoids any confusion with arrangements and means that we can ensure we have the correct staffing for all of our clubs and also means that no debt is being accrued. **Same day bookings and payments will not be accepted for any of these clubs so please book the day before.** If your child is not booked into a club, it is essential that your child is collected on time as we cannot add children to club lists. Your child will be safe but you will be requested to collect your child as soon as possible. If you need support with Arbor, please let our team know.

Questionnaire

On Monday, we will be sharing a questionnaire with you to find out your opinion about our new school meals from Relish. We will also be asking for your view on children not wearing shoes in school. I have had several parents and carers raising concerns about this and I want to know your opinions. I will share more on this on Monday. Finally, the questionnaire will be asking you the best time for us to hold our relaunched LEAF meeting!
